Long-Term-Care Plan

All active members receive the optional initial benefit amount of \$1,000 per month in coverage from the **City Employees Club of Los Angeles**.

Legislation

For over 35 years, LAAPOA has had a record of legislative involvement. It definitely helps that a current LAAPOA Board member is a member of the Board of Directors for PORAC, one of the largest statewide organizations at over 75,000 members. PORAC is a strong component of our legislative success.

Political Action

With voluntary contributions to the LAAPOA PAC coupled with great political advice from some of the best in the business, LAAPOA's PAC has been used wisely and is a direct part of the success or demise of many campaigns.

Bargaining Unit

LAAPOA is the exclusive bargaining unit for the sworn police officers and firefighters of the Los Angeles Airport Police Department and is the only union recognized by the City of Los Angeles to negotiate their wages, benefits, hours and working conditions. Only LAAPOA members have the right to ratify a potential contract. The following are just a few examples of previous and recent successes:

- Avoided any salary or benefit cuts, layoffs or furloughs during the budget crisis
- Pension enhancement option of LAFPP Tier 6
- Increase of 18% for pay parity
- Starting/Academy pay parity
- Added an additional 5.5% salary for step 7
- Increased longevity bonus
- Added retention bonus after five years
- Increased marksmanship bonus
- Implementation of compensated time off bank
- Added additional holiday pay
- 100% sick time cash out upon retirement
- Expansion of on-call pay to more members
- Implementation and expansion of bilingual and sign-language pay
- Actively working on equipment enhancements for park rangers
